



The Amsterdam Area:

The Amsterdam Metropolitan Area (AMA): **30** municipalities **2** provinces plus the Transport Authority Amsterdam

2.5m inhabitants **1.5m** jobs



More than **14%** of the Dutch population live in the Amsterdam Area

70% of all Amsterdam Area residents are born in the Netherlands

17% are long-term immigrants (i.e. residents for over 10 years)

13% are more recent immigrants (i.e. residents for less than 10 years)

78,555 are highly skilled migrants



16,305 are refugees





The majority is aged between **25-45** years old


The majority works in IT, business services and financial services

Highly skilled migrants mostly come from the EU (e.g. Germany (7%) France (6%)) and India (9%) Great Britain (9%) US (4%)



45% of highly skilled migrants who arrived in 2014 remained economically active in the region for five years or longer

70% of highly skilled migrants come with their partners



64% of highly skilled migrants live in Amsterdam, followed by Amstelveen, Haarlem and Almere



The majority lives in rental accommodation

29% of highly skilled migrants own a home
